But what does BSiF membership mean for us?

The BSiF is the trade body for the safety industry within the UK, their members consist of manufacturers, distributors, test houses, certification bodies, safety professionals and service providers. BSiF is firmly established as the major independent voice of the British safety industry, helping to both influence legislation and provide industry in general with a source of authoritative information on a range of workplace safety issues, while representing the needs of its members.

Through our company membership we demonstrate a strong commitment to safety and ethical trading and to improving health and safety for our employees, our suppliers and our customers. By choosing to become a member of the BSiF, we have recognised that health and safety is a force for good. We have made a commitment to keeping workers safe and healthy and partaking in the active effort required to make sure this happens.

What is the Registered Safety Supplier Scheme?

The BSiF and the Registered Safety Supplier Scheme is transforming the quality of PPE and the capability of economic operators in the UK Occupational Health and Safety Market whilst eliminating unsafe, non-compliant and illegal safety products and services that will help to keep people safe and healthy while they are at work.

We have signed a binding declaration that the safety equipment and services they offer meet the appropriate standards, fully complies with the PPE regulations and is correctly CE marked. As a result we are allowed to use the RSSS shield (below) to demonstrate our commitment.

The Mission of the scheme is to provide assurance to users that only compliant and correctly performing products are being supplied through a capable, educated, competent supply chain. The scheme provides a recognized route to enable a member to demonstrate compliance and due diligence – discharging the obligations of an economic operator under PPE Regulation (EU) 2016/425

A Registered Safety Supplier Scheme member...

- Formally declares and commits to selling only Certified PPE and safety products that perform to claims made
- Ensures that they meet all the responsibilities of the PPE Regulation (EU) 2016/425
- Submits their products to random independent performance testing
- Commits to having their customer facing staff educated and accredited in the Safe Supply Course
- Maintains a company Quality Policy
- As a Federation member trades honestly and ethically
